

Amnesty International is an international human rights organization, and its work encompasses various areas related to tolerance and combating discrimination.

One of the interesting campaigns by Amnesty International is "Write for Rights," an annual initiative by the organization. The goal of this campaign is to draw attention to specific cases of human rights violations and mobilize people to write letters of support and appeals to governments on behalf of victims of persecution and injustice.

In one edition of the "Write for Rights" campaign, the focus was on the case of Turkey, where **Turkish teachers Nuriye Gülmen and Semih Özakça** were compelled to go on a **hunger strike** in protest against their dismissal from their jobs as part of the purges carried out by the Turkish government. Amnesty International encouraged **people worldwide to write letters of support and appeals** on behalf of these teachers to the Turkish authorities, urging them to ensure a fair trial and to end the repression against human rights defenders in Turkey.
